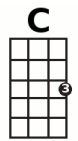

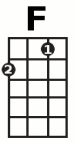

Amazing grace, how sweet the sound

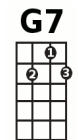


Am G7

I once was lost but now am found

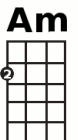


G7 C
